20x Expander Rivet 4,8x20,5 AL/AL (Bulbex) R68043

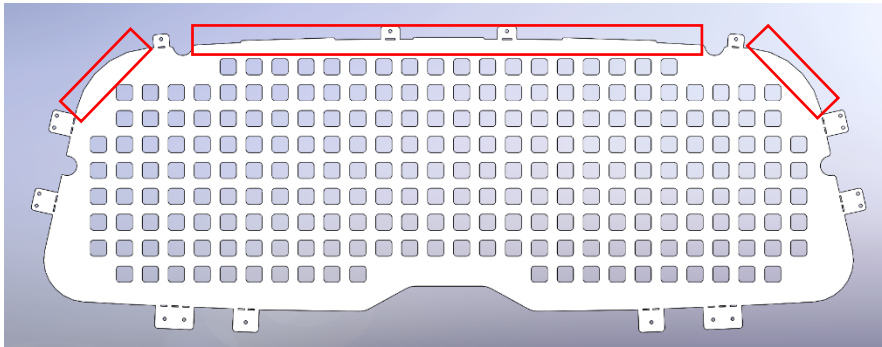
1.2 m Glue back cushion

1x Cleaner VHB cloth

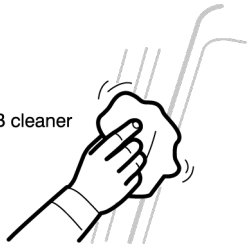
0.6 m Edging strip

Use “Cleaner VHB cloth” (R17091) on the highlighted areas.



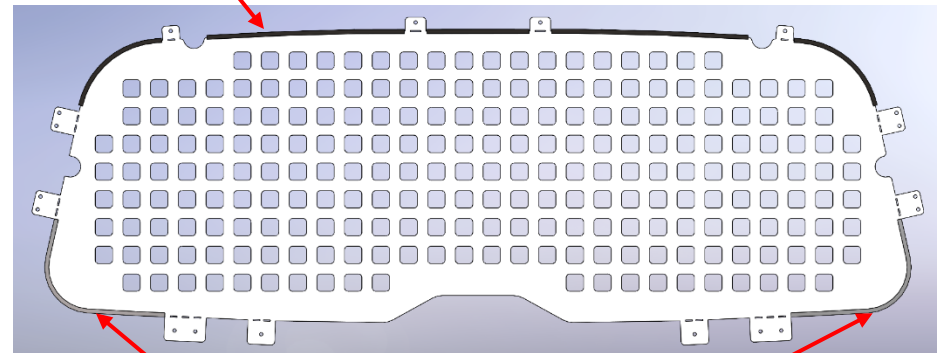

Cut the Edging strip (R61811) and Glue back cushion (R6292-L) to size. Remove backing cover and glue the cushion in place along the top edge and attach the edging strip on the lower corners.

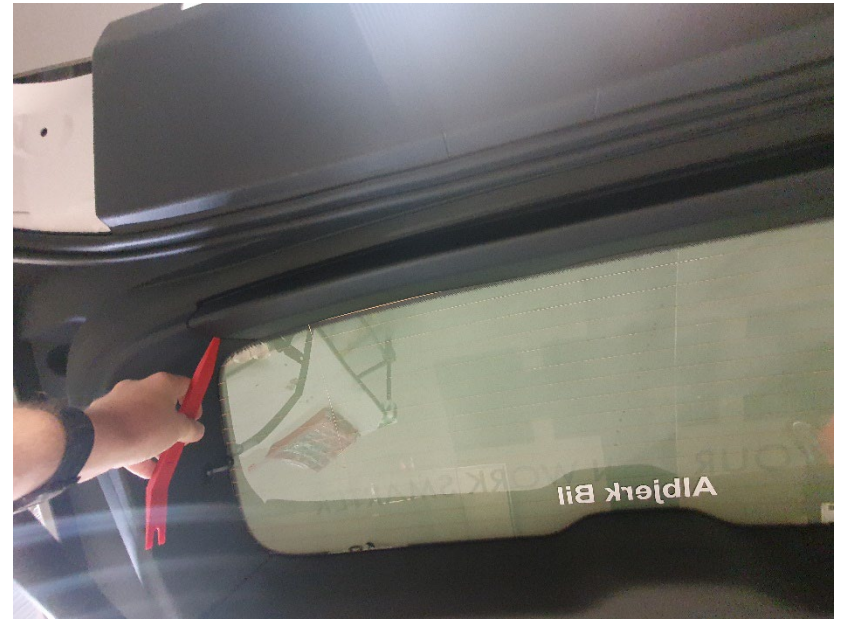
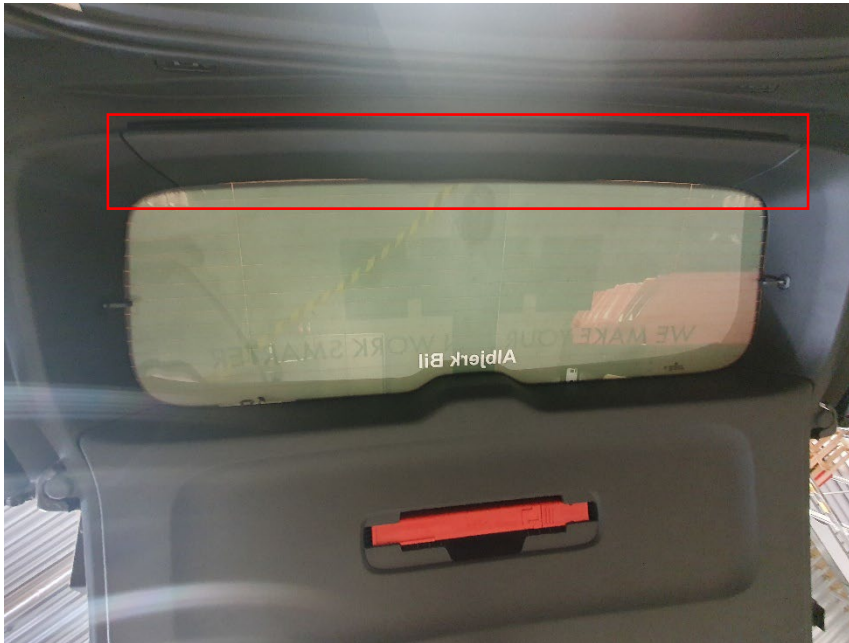

Remove the top plastic cover above the rear window of the tailgate using a plastic pry bar. It is mounted with spring loaded clips.

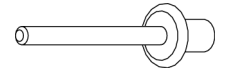
Bend the mounting tabs so the cushion side meets the glass at the top.
Fasten the top end to the plastic towers using expanding rivets.

When fastening the lower end, ensure the holes are **NO MORE than 30mm** from the window. Otherwise, there is a risk of missing the towers located behind the lower plastic cover (shown in picture below.)
Use expanding rivets to mount the lower end and sides to the vehicle.
